Based on the information available to us from our raw material suppliers, and our knowledge of the products' compositions, our Ultrafuse 316L filaments do not contain any substances mentioned in EU Directive 2011/65/EC:

- Mercury (Hg; 0.1%)
- Cadmium (Cd; 0.1%)
- Hexavalent chromium (Cr<sup>6+</sup>; 0.1%)
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB; 0.1%)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE; 0.1%)
- Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP; 0.1%)
- Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP; 0.1%)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP; 0.1%)
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP; 0.1%)

BASF does not routinely analyze the products for the presence of these substances. However, these substances are not expected to be present in the Ultrafuse 316L filaments in levels exceeding the limitations mentioned above.
